Code of Conduct for Young Golfers

As a young golfer taking part in a Lincoln Golf Club activity, you should:

- Help create and maintain an environment free of fear and harassment
- Demonstrate fair play and apply golf's standards both on and off the course
- Understand that you have the right to be treated as an individual
- Respect the advice that you receive
- Treat others as you would wish to be treated yourself
- Respect other people and their differences
- Look out for yourself and for the welfare of others
- Speak out (to your parents or a club representative) if you consider that you or others have been poorly treated
- Be organised and on time
- Tell someone in authority if you are leaving the venue
- Accept that these guidelines are in place for the well-being of all concerned
- Treat organisers and coaches with respect
- Observe instructions or restrictions requested by the adults looking after you

You should not take part in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour which includes:

- Smoking
- Using foul language
- Publicly using critical or disrespectful descriptions of others either in person or through text, email or social network sites
- Consuming alcohol, illegal performance-enhancing drugs or stimulants
- Care should be taken at all times when crossing the internal public roads
- Junior golfers should use extreme caution when in the vicinity of the internal water storage lake along the 7th and 15th fairways.
- Within the course boundaries there are a variety of drainage ditches, care must be taken at all times if playing in proximity to these ditches.
- All golfers must observe the Club rules if using the practice facilities.
